Forms were sent home on Friday, September 29, with each student. Again this year the Cape Girardeau Health Center will only be offering the **injectable** flu vaccine, **no flu mist**. The Center for Disease Center has recommended against the flu mist vaccine for flu protection. If you would like your child(ren) to have this vaccine, complete the form and return it to the school office with the necessary payment or Medicaid number before Friday, October 6, 2017 at 8 a.m. as the Cape County Health Dept. will pick up the forms that morning.
